Subject: Certificate of Cooperation with California Proposition 65

Dear Customer,

California Proposition 65 (the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) refers to the California legislation that was intended by its authors to protect California citizens and the State's drinking water sources from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and to inform citizens about exposures to such chemicals.

Proposition 65 requires businesses to notify Californians about exposure to significant amounts of chemicals in the products they purchase, in their homes or work-places, or that are released into the environment. By providing this information, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about protecting themselves from exposure to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Occupational or end-user exposure means an exposure that results from a person's acquisition, purchase, storage, consumption, or any reasonably foreseeable use of the finished product. The amount a user is exposed to is determined by the accessibility of substances at the surface of a product; how, and how long or often, the user is exposed to that surface in the course of a day; and how readily the substance is released from that surface under the actual use cases. Assessing these details requires understanding of the occupational processes or end user product, and may require the supervision of a knowledgeable toxicologist.

embeddedTS does not have knowledge of how our products are incorporated into our customers' end products and how the customer's occupational or end-user customer is using and handling it in finished goods. As such, embeddedTS takes a conservative stance and warns customers to use prudent caution when handling electronic components.

The electronics industry has standardized around the European RoHS and REACH standards, and the United States TSCA standard for reporting on chemicals that may pose hazards to the environment or human health. embeddedTS has followed the rest of the industry's lead in this matter and actively screens our component selection to comply to the RoHS, REACH, and TSCA standards, and can provide detailed materials disclosures in support of these standards.

embeddedTS does not knowingly discharge any chemicals into sources of drinking water.

embeddedTS offers a wide range of electronic devices designed with a diverse selection of components and materials. Our products may contain chemicals known to
