## **Subject: Certificate of Cooperation with IMERC Mercury-added Product Notification**

Dear Customer,

embeddedTS is aware of the Interstate Mercury Education & Reduction Clearinghouse (IMERC) Clearing house and their goals to reduce mercury in products and waste, particularly by supporting Mercury-added Product Notification.

embeddedTS does not knowingly or intentionally add Mercury to any of our products in any of our in house processes, and we do not knowingly discharge any chemicals, including Mercury, into sources of drinking water.

embeddedTS utilizes many electronic components from many different manufactures. The electronics industry has standardized around the European RoHS and REACH standards for reporting on chemicals, including mercury, which many be hazardous to the environment or humans. embeddedTS has followed the rest of the industry's lead in this matter and actively screens our component selection to comply to the RoHS and REACH standards. Unlike RoHS and REACH standards there are no mechanisms for collecting and cataloging Mercury's use as defined by IMERC on electronic components.

embeddedTS can provide the reports regarding the RoHS and REACH status of each electrical component used in our products, which includes a materials report which details any Mercury content. This report can be provided within 45 days of a written request, if the requestor signs a BOM Sharing Agreement restricting the use of shared information to proving compliance to environmental standards.
